Event: NP Stall at Monthly Market

Event Date: 15 June 2016

Venue: The Hill, Wickham Market 9am to 2pm
Facilitator: Neighbourhood Plan Committee
Format: Stand, Information and questions

Attendance: Total 19 People registered and talked to committee members

Aim of the Event

To introduce the Neighbourhood Plan and answer any questions. To encourage thoughts and ideas by using the information / response leaflet. Distribute information leaflet.

Who was Consulted

The aim of the stand was to engage and consult with as many members of the local community as possible. The stand was open to all shoppers attending the market and was publicised in an information / response leaflet which had been previously distributed to every household.

A total of 19 people registered at the stand. Each person was consulted. The majority came from the Parish

The attendees were made up of the following age groups:

Under 21 = 2

22-30 = 0

31-64 = 3

Over 64 = 16

One person who was new to the village expressed interest in serving on the Neighbourhood Plan Committee.

How people were consulted

The Market Stall was set up under a gazebo and incorporated a stand with information boards, a sign in process to include age group and a map to record where in the Parish the visitor came from. The stand also had information / response leaflets for distribution. 4 Members of the Neighbourhood Plan Committee were in attendance during the event.

Issues, priorities and concerns raised

On the day and direct discussion the following opinions, concerns were raised:

- 1) More events should take place on the Hill.
- 2) Please don't change the character of the village with large development
- 3) Traffic must be slowed down. Pedestrians must be given priority
- 4) What is happening with the pub?
- 5) Sensitive design for any development
- 6) Parking on pavements needs to be stopped
- 7) Not enough to do in Wickham Market
