### Issues, priorities and concerns raised

On the day and direct discussion the following opinions, concerns were raised:

- 1) 6 people hadn't received an information / response leaflet.
- 2) Not happy with the current bus service. Not as friendly as previous company
- 3) Only the outward bound (Saxmundham) bus timetable was shown in the bus shelter
- 4) Traffic Calming and crossings needed to be created to Health Centre.

Further opinions and thoughts were requested via the NP introduction / response leaflet.
